Show Fees:

Option A (does not include solo): \$160.00 per skater. Includes \$90 show fee and \$70 costume fee. 10% discount for additional family members off of the show fee (not discounted from costume fee). Show fee includes 10 practices, 1 Dress Rehearsal, music editing, choreography for and participation in the Opening and Finale numbers, as well as a Small Group number, performed both nights of the show. Skaters will need to purchase their own tights.

Option B (includes solo for one night*): \$250.00 per skater. Includes \$180 show fee and \$70 costume fee. 10% discount for additional family members off of the show fee (not discounted from costume fee). Show fee includes 10 practices, 1 Dress Rehearsal, music editing, choreography for and participation in the Opening and Finale numbers, as well as a Small Group number, performed both nights of the show. *Additionally, skaters below the Juvenile level will have the opportunity to perform a solo during one of the shows; Skaters at the Juvenile level and higher will perform both nights. Skaters will need to purchase their own tights.

*No skaters will be added to the cast after October 12th unless special permission has been obtained

Attendance:

All skaters are expected to attend all practices unless there is an unavoidable conflict. SkateNation Plus reserves the right to withdraw any skater who misses more than 3 practices; no refund will be given. **If you anticipate a conflict please let your coach know and email Show Director Olga Mudrak at olgamudrak@me.com**

Solo Information:

Please submit music choice to Lea Rizer (learizer@hotmail.com) for approval before starting choreography with a private coach. Solo costumes/props are left to the discretion of the skater. Below is a general timeframe for solo lengths:

Snowplow levels through Basic 5 – 45 seconds
Basic 6 through Freeskate 1 – 1 minute
Freeskate 2 through Freeskate 6, and No Test – 1 minute 15 seconds
Pre-Preliminary through Pre-Juvenile – 1 minute 30 seconds
Juvenile and Intermediate – 1 minute 45 seconds
Novice through Senior – 2 minutes

**Skaters wishing to do a solo must sign up for the entire show. Exceptions may be made in special circumstances at the discretion of the Skating and Show Directors

Duets & Trios:

Duets and Trios performed in lieu of a solo will perform in both nights of the show

Registration:

Skaters must register at the Front Desk **before** attending their first practice. Skaters may also sign up on Saturday, September 28th at the first practice, although early registration is encouraged so Directors and Coaches can plan ahead

Groups:

Small Group selection will be at the discretion of the coaches, and is based on the choreography demands for each group. Thank you in advance for your cooperation
